I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter dated the 30th ultimo in reference to repairs at Qu'Appelle Industrial school, and in reply to say that the Department approves of the renewing of flooring and railing in verandahs where necessary at that school, also the painting of the dining-room, as recommended by you.

The walks may also be rebuilt in concrete wherever these are in such condition that they are no longer serviceable.


The necessary materials may be purchased by you, and delivered to the school as economically as possible, observing the regulations respecting purchases.

This is being authorized on condition that the work will be done by, and at the cost of the school.
