

all the business and other affairs of the Society shall be regulated, except as hereinafter prescribed. The Council shall have the power to fill all vacancies occurring in its body during the session.

V.—MODE OF PROCEDURE.

The ordinary meetings of the Society shall be governed by the rules of the Dominion House of Commons, as far as practicable, and by such special "Rules of Debate" as may be, from time to time, adopted by a majority of the members at the annual or a special general meeting. Every ordinary meeting shall be presided over by the Speaker, or in his absence the Deputy-Speaker, and it shall be his duty to follow the methods of the House of Commons as closely as possible in every form of procedure not otherwise prescribed for herein.

VI.—DURATION OF SESSION, ETC.

The Society shall meet weekly from October to April, inclusive, at such place and on such nights as may be determined by the Council, but, at the will of the House, extra meetings (for debate on adjourned business only) shall be held at any time.

VII.—MEMBERSHIP FEE.

The annual membership fee shall be one dollar, and shall be payable upon election, or at the commencement of every session.
