Facts About the Banana

The fruit is brought to our northern markets green, and is ripened by artificial heat. The color of the peel gives evidence of the degree of ripeness. The green banana contains in the part exclusive of the skin, about 15 per cent of protein, and 20 to 25 per cent of carbohydrates, almost entirely starch. In the ripe banana, with yellow-brown peel, the edible part contains somewhat less (16 to 18 per cent) of carbohydrates, but the starch remains in now almost entirely in the form of soluble sugars.

ADVANCE IN TIN PRICES IN LONDON

Mail advices from London just at hand state that the gradual upward movement in prices of tin is based on legitimate trade prospects.

The market is now absolutely free from "cornering" tactics, the premium on cash metal being only about 1/2 per cent, although the London warehouse stock is only 1971 tons.

The condition of the Welsh tinplate trade for some months past has been rather disappointing. This may be partly ascribed to the fact that the works have found it difficult to recover from the setback of the coal strike.

CONFIDENCE IS GROWING IN THE WEST

Winnipeg reports show that as crop prospects become more assured, confidence is growing and trade is improving. While banks are restricting loans for speculative purposes, there is little fear that moderate accommodations for legitimate business expansions will not be provided.
