What is the best estimate of the amount spent by the Department of Public Works in the Constituency of Kootenay West from (a) 1968 to 1974 (b) 1974 to date?

Hon. Judd Buchanan (Minister of Public Works): (a) The amount of money spent by the Department of Public Works from its own appropriations from April 1, 1971 to March 31, 1974 was \$878,708. A total of \$1,180,485 was spent by the Department of Public Works on behalf of other government departments. (b) The amount of money spent by the Department of Public Works from its own appropriations from April 1, 1974 to June 30, 1977 was \$1,002,930. A total of \$783,352 was spent by the Department of Public Works on behalf of other government departments. Information for the period prior to April 1, 1971 is unavailable as the government's Record Disposal Policy requires financial information to be retained for a period of six years only.

Hon. John Roberts (Secretary of State): I am informed by the National Museums: The Museum Assistance Programmes, since their inception in 1972, have awarded grants totalling \$145,700 to the Kootenay Doukhobor Historical Society National Exhibition Centre in the Constituency of Kootenay West. (a) In the 1973-74 fiscal year, a grant of \$100,000 (under the Capital Assistance Programme) was awarded to the Kootenay Doukhobor Historical Society National Exhibition Centre to assist the construction of the National Exhibition Centre facility. (b) from 1974 to date, three grants totalling \$45,700 have been awarded the Kootenay Doukhobor Historical Society National Exhibition Centre, as follows: 1976-77: \$20,000 under the Core-Funding Assistance Programme; 1977-78: \$20,000 under the Core-Funding Assistance Programme; \$5,700 under the Special Activities Assistance Programme; total \$45,700.
