ECLIPSES IN 1848.

There will be Six Eclipses this year, *four* of the SUN, and *two*
 of the MOON. There will also be a transit of the Planet MERCURY.

I. March 5, a partial eclipse of the Sun, invisible to the great-
 er part of British North America—it will be seen at Labrador,
 Newfoundland and Greenland.

II. March 19, a total eclipse of the Moon, part of which will
 be visible in the British Provinces:—
