room or other place of meeting, for all business connected with their respective Parishes (except the choice of officers) on the Saturday before Easter Monday in every year; and notice of such meeting shall be given by the Rec-

tor on the Sunday previous.

35. A full and detailed statement and account of the re-19 Vic. c 50, s 7. ceipts and expenditure of the Corporation for the past year shall be laid before such meeting, and any information required by any pew holder or person qualified to vote for Church Wardens and Vestrymen, respecting the same, or respecting the property of the Corporation and the management thereof, shall be given.

Union of Parishes.

35. Any person duly inducted into the Rectory of any Church shall be deemed to be the Rector of any other Church or Churches in the same or any other Parish, upon being chosen thereto by the Parishioners according to law, and upon receiving letters of institution from the Bishop giving him spiritual charge thereof, and there being no other legally licensed Priest or Deacon in holy orders officiating in such other Parish, but he shall have no power to fell, cut down, or take away any of the timber or wood growing on any part of the Glebe, without the authority of the Church Wardens and Vestry in the manner heretofore provided in the twenty-seventh section of this Act.

Division of Parishes.

36. Each of the several Parishes, constituted by law, shall as heretofore be and continue an ecclesiastical Parish under the terms of this Act, unless division thereof shall be made as hereinafter provided.

27. In the case of any Parish wherein no Church Corporation shall be established, the first meeting for the election of Church Wardens and Vestrymen may be summoned by any three communicants of the Church of England resident in such Parish at such time and place as they may appoint, and immediately upon such election being made, the said Church Wardens and Vestrymen shall be and become a body politic and corporate by the name of the Rector, Church Wardens and Vestry of the Church in such Parish, in accordance with the foregoing provisions of this Act.
