Official motion picture of the part taken by the United States in the war consists of 570,000 feet of film, enough to fill 142½ hours' continuous showing.

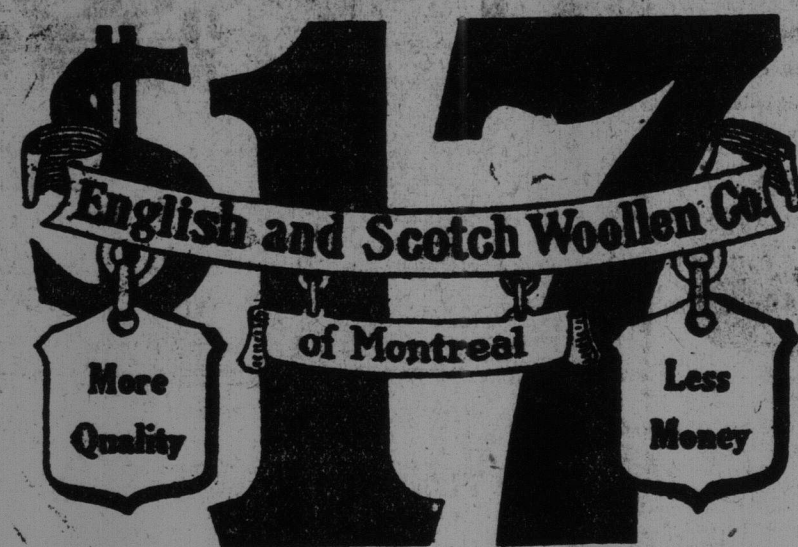
