

Canadian Commons To Consider Central Banking Control

Church Union Issue Likely
to be Joined on Tuesday
Evening.

MURDOCK CHARGES
Conservatives to Move That
Accusations are Proven—
Banking Matters.

Ottawa, June 16.—This week promises to provide plenty in the way of parliamentary interest, including amongst other things church union, the final proceedings on the Murdock charges and the new committee on the Canadian National estimates.

The church union issue will not be really joined in the House, according to present plans, until Tuesday evening. The bill is to be reported to the House today but will not be on the order paper for consideration until the evening following, when there is an hour set for the consideration of private bills. The first issue to come before the House in connection with this measure is the question of rescinding the Duff amendment which provides for referring the bill to the courts.

The report of the privileges and elections committee on the Murdock charges is now expected to be taken up in the Commons on Wednesday.

When the report comes into the House, it is understood that an amendment will be moved from the Conservative benches asserting that the charges against the minister have been "proven and sustained."

Proposed Central Bank.
Banking questions are scheduled for debate on Tuesday, when a proposal is to be made to instruct the banking and commerce to take up a proposal to establish a central bank.

The plan is understood to be not exactly in the nature of the Federal Reserve system of the United States, but rather a method of providing for control of the discount facilities under the Finance Act and coupling with that a system of bank inspection.

The new committee on the Canadian National estimates is to get down to work on Tuesday, when a proposal is to be made to instruct the banking and commerce to take up a proposal to establish a central bank.

The Senate is still busy with the Canadian National branch line bills. Nineteen of these bills have been dealt with so far by the Senate railway committee. In 17 cases the committee has given tentative approval, while the two Vancouver Island bills have been tentatively held up. No formal reports have been made and the decision on the Vancouver Island bills is still subject to review. There are still seven other branch line bills to come before the committee and these are expected to be taken up during the coming week.

**WEEK-END IS BUSY BELIEVE CANADA
ONE FOR FIREMEN ON THE UPGRADE**

Six Fire Calls Sent in During Saturday and Sunday.

The week-end was a busy one for the firemen of the city, no less than six calls for their services being sent in on Saturday and Sunday. Three were still alarms. The stills were for a blaze in the butcher shop of C. A. Nichols, 462 Main street, where an oil stove was upset and the warehouse of the Peerless Coal Co., corner of Crown and Mecklenburg streets. Little damage was done.

The bell calls were for more serious fires. The first was from Box 421 for a blaze in a shed owned by J. W. Forrestell, Gilbert's Lane. It started from an explosion of gasoline while the owner was making repairs to his automobile and in a few minutes both car and shed were a mass of flames. A hoise next door, owned by Mrs. Robert Carr, was quite badly damaged by fire and water. This house was occupied by Mrs. A. J. Leary on the ground floor and Mr. Leary on the upper floors. Mrs. O'Leary had \$500 insurance but the other tenants had no insurance. It is understood there is insurance enough on the building to cover the damage.

There was no insurance on the shed of Mr. Forrestell or the automobile of Mr. Greer. The total loss is estimated at about \$2,000.

Yesterday morning about 11 o'clock an alarm from Box 24 called the west side firemen out for a blaze in the two-story building at the corner of German and Watson streets, owned by Robert McIntosh and occupied by himself and William Connor. The fire, the origin of which is unknown, started in the attic and before it had been extinguished considerable damage had been done. The fire had worked up into the roof and walls and it was found necessary to cut holes in the roof of the main building and all before the all out was sounded. The damage to the building and McIntosh's furniture is understood to be covered by insurance but Mr. Connor was without insurance.

ROUMANIAN RULERS ASK ALLIES

FOR AID AGAINST THE RUSSIANS

Rival Claims for Bessarabia a Menace to the Peace of Europe.

Geneva, June 16.—(United Press)—In the recent visit of King Ferdinand and Queen Marie to the League of Nations and the principal powers of the Allies, European political experts profess to see Rumania's preparation for a showdown with Russia on the question of Bessarabia, which she claims as a part of her territory. The possibility of the latter question only being settled by war constitutes, according to these experts, the most serious menace to European peace existing today.

And in the event of such a war, Rumania would be obliged to call upon one of two things, either the full support of the League of Nations or the support of the principal European powers of the Big Entente.

It was for the purpose of placing Rumania's position on this question squarely before the Big Entente that the Rumanian government, which has made there relative to Rumania's position in the league, but also similar declarations of league support extending to the League of Nations in their formal public greetings.

That Rumania would prefer the full support of the League of Nations is said to be indicated not only by the prestige of his visit to Geneva and the unmistakable declarations which he made there relative to Rumania's position in the league, but also similar declarations of league support extending to the League of Nations in their formal public greetings.

Claims Bessarabia.
King Ferdinand declared while in Geneva: "Bessarabia was assigned to Rumania after a full expression of its popular will to that effect, by the treaty signed at Paris, October 28, 1920, between England, France, Italy, Japan and Rumania. Rumania stands for the integral and loyal respect of existing treaties, and she intends to call on the League of Nations, should the occasion arise, to see that the obligations under the covenant for the maintenance of her rights and territory."

No question exists in any one's mind as to what Tchitcherine's reply would be to the Rumanian appeal. He would undoubtedly accept the obligations of league membership.

With Russia's refusal known in the event of Rumania's appeal to the league, it is pointed out that the league will create the most serious test to which the league has ever been subjected.

Unfortunately for the league in this connection, Russia has virtually no financial or economic relations with anyone and has demonstrated for a number of years that she can get along very well without the outside financial and economic relations.

All that the council could then do would be to recommend under Article 10 that the members of the league take military and naval action against Russia in support of Rumania. But here again Article 10 provides that all the council can do is to make a recommendation and it is then for leagues themselves to decide whether or not they wish to carry out the recommendation.

As a consequence in the final analysis of an eventual appeal of Rumania to the League of Nations, the principle European members of the league would have to decide for themselves whether in pursuance of their obligations under the covenant and upon recommendation of the league council, they might wish to go to Rumania's support.

According to international experts, King Ferdinand probably assured himself during the course of his visit to the European capitals that enough of the big powers will respond to the appeal of the league not only to save Rumania, but to save the league itself.

Chicago, June 15.—A man with five bullet wounds in his body was taken to the County Hospital yesterday, where he was arrested and held in connection with Thursday's sensational mail robbery. The police made three arrests and held their prisoners for questioning. The wounded man, J. H. Wayne, was found lying in front of a house on the West Side. The police have been endeavoring to find either the dead or wounded bandit who was shot during the train holdup.

Estimates of the amount obtained by the bandits still vary from \$100,000 to \$300,000. A. E. Gerner, chief postal inspector, believes they did not obtain more than the lower figure, but Larry Benson, chief of the railroad's police force, estimates it at close to \$200,000.
