Sir:-

In reply to your letter of the 9th. inst. regarding the proposed purchase by the Indians of the buildings left on the Seabird Island Reserve by the timber licensee, it is noted that the value of these buildings is placed at \$1670 as represented by 167.000 f.b.m. of lumber.

As the Seabird Shingle Co. have indicated their willingness to dispose of these for the sum of \$600 I have to state that you should secure a resolution of the band asking that this sum be expended for the purpose specified, and forward same to the Department as soon as possible.
