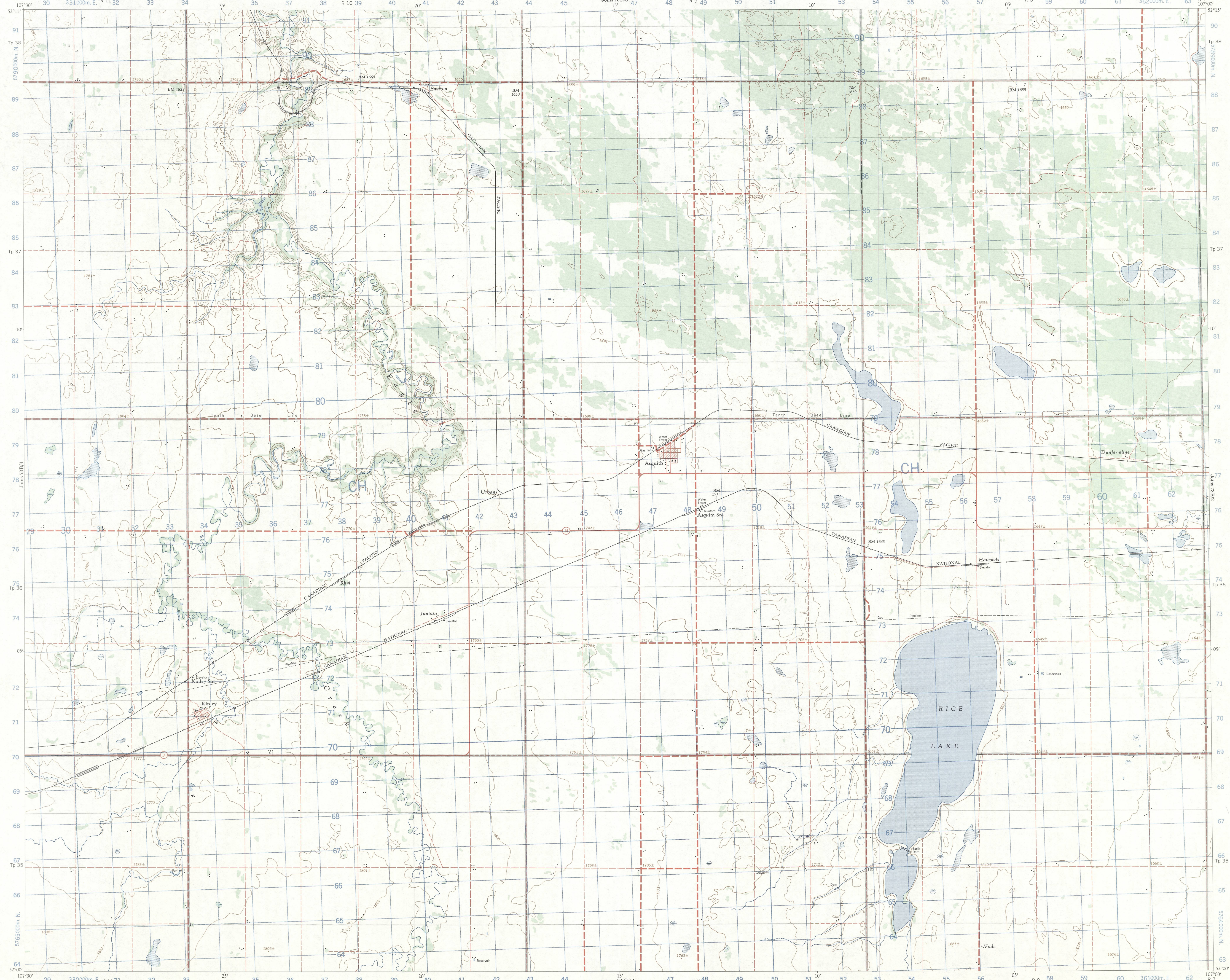

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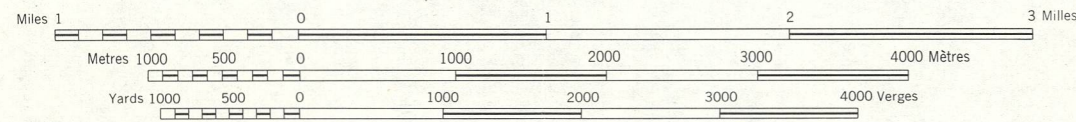

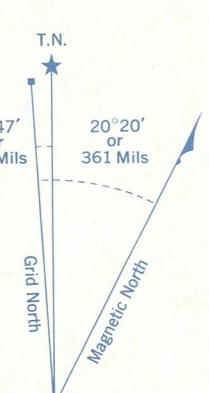

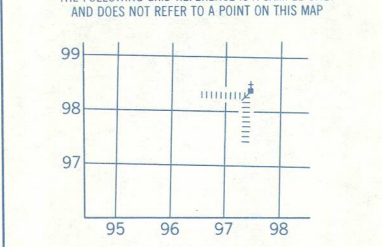

EXAMPLE OF METHOD USED TO GIVE A REFERENCE TO NEAREST 100 METRES



REFERENCE POINT	CHURCH (see above)
EXISTING: Road number on grid line immediately to left of point	97
Estimated length of square from this line eastward to point	15
NORTHING: Road number on grid line immediately below point	98
Estimated length of square from this line northward to point	4
EXAMPLE MILITARY GRID REFERENCE	975084
Nearest smaller grid reference	100,000 metres (about 63 miles)
