Professor Haeckel, old man, whose death was announced recently, is heralded in the press as the most famous German scientist. Paul Ewald, Germany's famous physiologist and bacteriologist, set up Haeckel as follows: "On reading Haeckel, despite modern allusions, one finds himself carried back to a time when the act of strictly logical thinking had not as yet been invented and when positive science was still in its childhood stages."
