Any person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land...

Duties - Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years...

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his homestead...

A homesteader who has exhausted his homestead right and cannot obtain a pre-emption may take a purchased homestead in certain districts...
