

100,000 MILE RUN BY AUTO


Montague Roberts, Driving Abbott-Detroit Car, to Start on Record Journey, Including Canada in Tour.

HOW TO MEASURE TREES AND RIVERS



To measure distance fairly accurately you must cultivate a uniform step and then learn how many steps you take to a given distance, which should be 100 yards or more.

This will set you facing at right angles to the line AB. Standing thus bring your palms together fully extended. A sight taken over your thumbs will give you a line AD, at right angles to the line AB.

Now we know that each of the five inches in the line AC stands for 100 yards on the ground. So if our ruler shows us that the line AB is seven inches long we know it is about 700 yards from A to B.
