New York, March 26.—The market

opened steady, active and in 4 in

ever, were very light and it was ob-

vious that any bullish news would

bring a rally. This came later in the

day in the shape of the Western belt

forecast and reports of threatening

high waters in Southern rivers. Un-

der this stimulus of a comparatively

small volume of business prices grad-

ually rallied from their early reaction

and the final hour witnessed fair ac-

tivity with shorts on the run. Reports

from the Southwest were fairly cheer-

ful as regarded the progress of crop

preparations but the same reports in-

dicated a substantial curtailment of

acreage. Opinion is gradually crystal-

lizing around the theory of a smaller

crop next year and if the weather

should continue backward for another

fortnight the new crop months will

likely furnish a medium for profitable

investment.
