

PRIZE MONEY IS BEING MAILED TO NAVAL MEN NOW

Dept. Has an Incomplete List of Present Addresses so Many May be Overlooked.

Ottawa, Nov. 25.—A large number of cheques have been distributed by the Department of the Naval Service for prize money to men who have served in the U. S. Navy.

The minimum service required to qualify for naval prize money is one month's service in an offensive armed seagoing ship of war between August 4th, 1914 and November 11th, 1918.

MODERATE PARTIES WEAKEN IN SAXONY

Diet Election Reflects Political Drift Evident in Germany Since January 1919.

(Copyright, 1920, By Public Ledger.) Berlin, Nov. 25.—The Diet elections in Saxony show the same political drift which has characterized every election in Germany since the revolutionary elections for a constituent assembly in January, 1919.

The moderate elements among the Socialists and the bourgeois Liberals alike and a growing tendency to divide into two sharply hostile camps—conservative and radical labor.
