In reply to your letter dated the 12th May, I am directed by the Earl of Kimberley to inform you that no Blue Book has been published on the subject of the Expedition against the Chilicoten Indians, undertaken by the Government of British Columbia in 1864, but that there are in this Department two Maps, the one being the fifth sheet of the Survey of the Colony taken by Captain Parsons R. E. in 1863, including the country North East of Bute Inlet as far as Tete Jaune Cache and the other being a sketch map of the country east of Bute Inlet, comprising the place where Brewster's party was massacred, and the place where the Murderers surrendered on the 15 August 1864.

His Lordship will be happy to allow you to inspect these Maps here, and if you desire, to take tracings, or copies of them.
