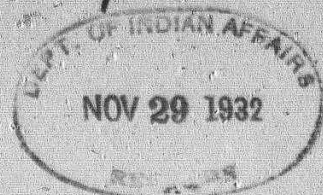

"The solicitors for the defendant have pointed out to us the desirability of an early decision being made in this matter, because if the settlement suggested is agreed to it may be necessary for the town in preparing for the assessment for next year to take the payments due under the settlement into consideration.
