O'CONNOR, HAMILTON PARKE. (*South Bruce.*)

Grandfather, James Bligh O'Connor, late Captain in H.M. 96th Regt., came to Can. in 1836, and settled in the Co. of Middlesex. S. of Hamilton Bligh O'Connor, Clerk of the Division Court at Teeswater, Ont. B. 10 Nov., 1844, in London, Ont., and ed. at Goderich Grammar Sch. and at private schools. M., 1875, Jane Watkins, fourth dau. of Allan N. McLean, Esq., Toronto. Called to the Bar, Ont., 1878. Mayor of Walkerton, 1880 and 1881. First returned to Leg. Assem. for present seat, 18 Oct., 1882, to fill vacancy caused by resignation of Mr. R. M. Wells, elected to the Commons. Re-elected by acclamation at g.e. 1883. Re-elected at g.e. 1886. OSTROM, GILBERT WELLINGTON. (*West Hastings.*)

B. at Belleville, Ont., June, 1837. Ed. at Albert Coll. Called to the Bar, 1869, and, after practising in Belleville, removed to Trenton in 1877. Has been Reeve and Deputy Reeve, and was elected Mayor of Trenton by acclamation in 1886. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last g.e. A Conservative.—*Trenton, Ont.*

PACAUD, GASPARD. (*North Essex.*)

Great grandfather came to Canada as an officer in the French Army. Father, P. N. Pacaud, a Notary Public and a banker, residing in Ste. Hyacinthe, P. Q., was a personal friend of Papineau, and took an active part in the Rebellion of 1837-8, by which he was completely ruined. B. at St. Norbert d'Arthabaska, P. Q., 24 June, 1859. Ed. at Archambault's Academy, Montreal, and in classics at Nicolet and Three Rivers Seminaries. Studied law for a few months. Is a journalist and editor of *Le Progress* newspaper. First returned to Leg. Assem. at last g. e. A Liberal.—*Windsor, Ont.*

PARDEE, TIMOTHY BLAIR, Q.C. (*West Lambton.*)
