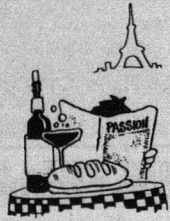

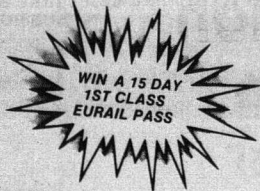

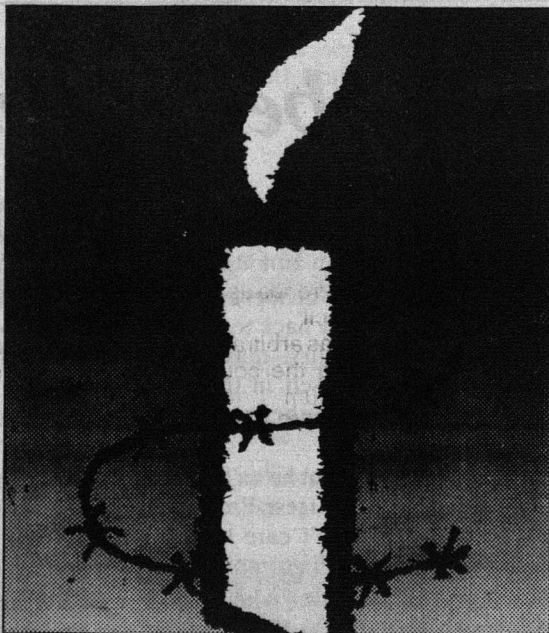

Revenge no factor for Dinos

Last season, the Calgary Dinosaur hockey club won the Canada West title, in a 8-6 deciding game victory in Calgary over the Golden Bears. Although the Bears are looking towards this weekend with revenge on their minds, the Dinos don't seem too concerned over Alberta's motivation for this season's three round Canada West title bout.

"No one down here is really thinking about it," said Dino coach Willie Desjardins. "It doesn't matter what happened last year."

Desjardins won't have problems thinking about last year's series, because this is his first year behind the Dino bench. He took over at the beginning of the season from George Kingston, who is now an

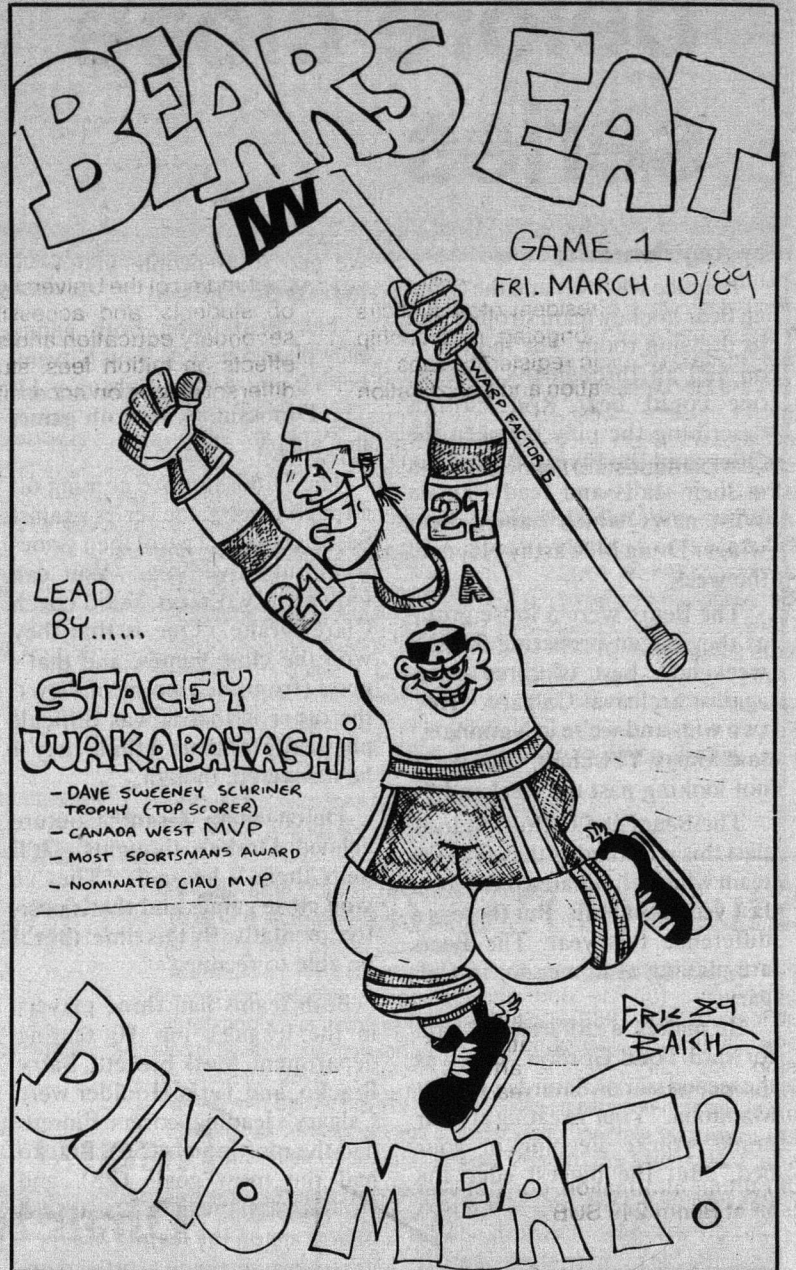

assistant with the Minnesota North Stars.

This matchup is totally different than the two semi-final series last weekend. Both series were classic offence versus defence matchups. This series has the one big line battle. Calgary's unit of Barry Bracko, Mark Fioretti, and Terry Houlder matches up quite well with Alberta's number one crew of Sid Cranston, Stacey Wakabayashi, and Doug McCarthy. All six were in the top ten in Canada West scoring.

"That line is good," Desjardins said of Alberta's top line, "but all of our lines have to play well because Alberta's has three good lines."

The Bears were hoping that Calgary would be banged up after their three game series with the Saskatchewan Huskies. The Dinos scraped two overtime victories from the Huskies, the second



coming with four minutes left in double overtime.

"We came out not bad," Desjardins said. "We're pretty healthy considering the series was pretty physical. We got a few bumps and bruises but overall, we were pretty lucky."

The two teams split the four conference matchups, including both in Calgary, when they shut down the vaunted Alberta power play, which clicked 38% of the time in the regular season.

While the Dinos have had little trouble in Calgary, they've had their problems the last two seasons playing before the rowdy crowd

in Varsity Arena. Last year they were winless in Edmonton in Canada West play and this year was more of the same. The Bears, who have as much trouble on Calgary ice, are hoping that a lager-lusting crowd comes into play like it did when they last played Calgary at home. The Bears defeated the Dinos 6-3 in front of 3000 screaming people. They definitely played an outcome on the game.
