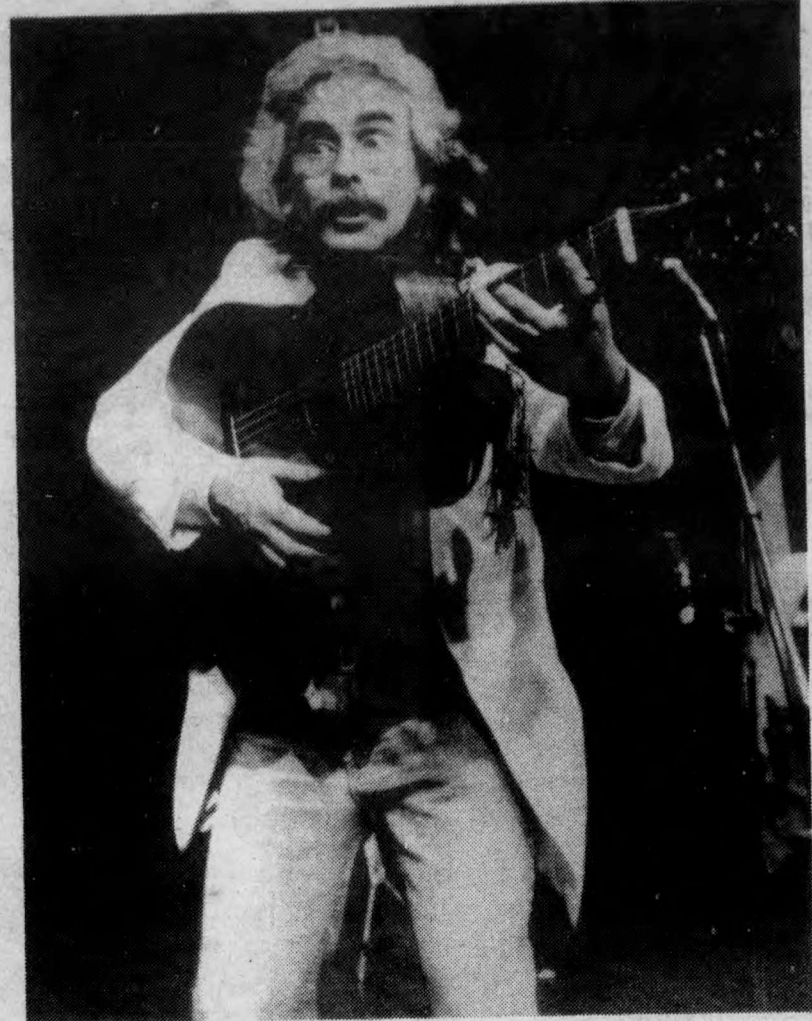
Foods, Westminster Books, Regent Craft Gallery and at the door.
