Dear Sir,-

I regret that your letter of June 14th last with reference to certain mining claims in the Abitibi Indian Reserve has been overlooked.

This Department is agreeable to your Department selecting an additional area equivalent to that covered by those parts of mining claims 42 T.P. and 43 T.P., on the west shore of South Bay of Lower Lake Abitibi, which were staked before the selection of the Reserve was confirmed. You can make a selection at the north west corner of the Reserve, north of Lot 1, Concession 6, Township of Milligan. Lot 1, concession 6 has been located to a Veteran and is not available.

It might be a difficult matter at present to have a survey made and as the shore line of Abitibi has been carefully surveyed a description by metes and bounds could be prepared by this Department covering the area, if you would indicate on a sketch the land you wish to select.

I will require to ascertain from the Mining Recorder for that District if any mining claims have ever been recorded which might encroach on your selection before finally disposing of the matter.
