Goble and members of Party arrived in Douglas Digby, with Wing Commander Kennedy and Wing Commander ^{Coleman} at the controls. The Prime Minister of Australia was first greeted by the Prime Minister of Canada and the High Commissioner for Australia to Canada. The other officials who were here to greet him were then introduced in turn. The Prime Minister of Australia then posed with the Prime Minister of Canada for press photographs and after a few moments of informal chats with the various dignitaries proceeded to his car. The party then moved from the Aerodrome to inspect the Guard of Honour, which was drawn up under Command of Flight Lieutenant R.F. Begg on the Barrack Area, immediately inside the main gate. The R.C.A.F. Central Band played General Salute and then continued playing throughout this ceremony. The party then returned to their cars and proceeded back to the Aerodrome where Course 23 consisting entirely of Australians, were drawn up under the Command of Flying Officer K.L. Morhan. The Prime Minister of Australia inspected the Australians and later informally addressed them. He then said good-bye to the Commanding Officer and got in his car to proceed to Government House where he will be the guest of His Excellency, the Governor General, while in Ottawa.
