Sgt. Buddy Hellyer Wins Honors in R. C. A. F. Sports Day at Uplands

Cpl. Joyce Lockwood Winner Three Events to Top Airwomen

Placing first in three events, Sgt. Buddy Hellyer took individual honors with an aggregate score of 15 points in the annual Uplands Service Flying School sports day held yesterday. Repair Squadron won the C.O.'s trophy for the team aggregate score. Topping the Women's Division, was Cpl. Joyce Lockwood with 13 points.

Close to 500 contestants took part in the field day which included track and field events, swimming races and diving. The prizes were presented in the evening by Group Captain Raymond, Commanding Officer of the station, at a dance with music by the R.C.A.F. Central Band.

Hellyer, who starred with Air Force in the Senior City Hockey League last year and when they won the Allan Cup two years ago, scored his first victory in the shot put event and annexed the 220 yard race, completing his triple win in the broad jump. LAC. Cliff McClay was second with 14 points.

Cpl. Lockwood, of the Women's Division, was first in the softball throw, the slow bicycle race and the skipping race. Cpl. Betty Duncan placed second with 13 points.

In an exhibition softball game against Arnprior Flying School, Uplands scored a seven-inning 1-0 win. As another added feature, Uplands and Arnprior battled to a 3-3 deadlock in a soccer match. Flt.
