The Sumas Indians have been to see me about an alleged outstanding payment due them on account of the Sale of the No. 7 Reserve in 1919.

From correspondence on File here, it appears that this Reserve of 160 Acres was sold in 1919, and the sum of \$4,500.00 distributed among the Indians, who, however, claim that they were entitled to a distribution of \$6,000.00 and now wish to receive the balance of \$1,500.00.

I have no way of checking up their statements and shall be much obliged if you can let me have the necessary information from your Records.
