Canada, and we would ask your earnest consideration of sub-section 4 before this Bill is passed.

There is another feature that I am instructed to bring to your attention, and that is the fact that the Crow's Nest Pass Agreement only covers grain and flour, and no mention is made of other grain products. The Railways have always, in the past, applied the flour rates to all other grain products, but if the Railways apply the same strict interpretation to this part of the Agreement that they have in the case of the west-bound commodities, we fear that they may eliminate other grain products from the application of the Crow's Nest Pass rates. Such an interpretation would have a very serious effect on the business of Canada as practically all of the domestic shipments going to country points consist of mixed carloads, containing grain, flour, feed and other mill products.
