Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 4th Instant, requesting that you may be given an extension of time for payment of the next Instalment against the N.E. 1/4 Sec. 4, and the S.E. 1/4 Sec. 9, 52, 25, Stony Plain Reserve, by paying the Interest upon the unpaid balance, I have to inform you that in view of the circumstances as stated in your letter, the Department is willing to accept the Interest, which is as follows:- Upon the N.E. 1/4 Sec. 4, if paid on or before the 23rd June next, \$121.16, and upon the S.E. 1/4 Sec. 9, \$134.27, if paid by the same date, or a total of \$255.43.
