
Rev. Sir,-

I beg to refer you to your letter to this Department, dated March 2, 1914, in reference to the neglect on the part of the principal of the Alberni Boarding School in the forwarding of his quarterly returns of attendance, applications for the admission or discharge of pupils and other correspondence in connection with this school.

The quarterly return of attendance for the September quarter last, has not yet reached the Department and the delay of the principal in the forwarding of his returns hampers the work of the Department and affects your church by the delay in the receipt of the cheque for the quarterly grant.
