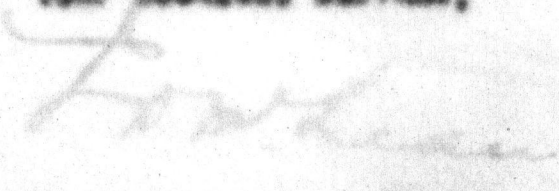

I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo enclosing a communication from the Rev. Canon Stocken, Acting Principal of the Old Sun Boarding school, in which he asks the Department to furnish the school with a windmill for pumping water for the stock.

In reply I beg to say that you may purchase a windmill for this school from Mr. J. A. Renshaw, Gleichen, and the cost should not exceed the amount quoted in Canon Stocken's letter, viz.- \$25.00 for one with a twenty foot galvanized steel tower and a six foot windmill.
