I have, therefore, to inform you that if you do not see that your children attend school regularly the Department will be compelled to take action under the Reguletions Relating to the Education of Indian Children to have them committed to a residential school. You fourself have them committed to a residential school. You fourself are liable to fine or imprisonment if you neglect, after are liable to fine or imprisonment if we neglect after be ach day it receiving this notice, to see that they attend each day it is open and that they remain there during the regular school hours.

It is hoped that you will heed this notice and that there will be no need to take action as mentioned above and that you will see that your children attend school tach day in future.
