Dear Sir:-

When I visited the Indians at Enderby B. C. on April 25th among the many questions discussed, one was the Shuswap and Okanagan Railway right-of-way through their reserve. This railway was built, I think, in 1891. There is not a time that I meet those Indians but they bring up this question. I have asked them why they have not got these matters settled long ago. It is so difficult to deal with questions of this kind at so late a date. I am told they endeavoured to do this; but could get no reply from their agent. If this question has been settled, please advise me, and I will give those Indians the answer and inform them to bring up the question no more at any meeting. If it has not been properly or finally settled, advise what can be done. I want to clear up the question with the Indians.
