ARMY ACT.

COMMITTING A CIVIL OFFENCE, THAT IS TO SAY, WHILE HAVING IN HIS POSSESSION SKETCHES WHICH HE OBTAINED OWING TO HIS POSITION AS A PERSON WHO HOLDS OFFICE UNDER HIS MAJESTY, COMMUNICATES SUCH SKETCHES TO PERSONS OTHER THAN PERSONS TO WHOM HE IS AUTHORIZED TO COMMUNICATE THEM, CONTRARY TO SEC. 2(1)(a) OF THE OFFICIAL SECRETS ACT, 1911,

in that he

in the Field, on or about 9 November 1942, communicated sketches, namely photographs of tanks, tank landing craft and other munitions of war to Walter John SIMMONS, an employee of Messrs. Boots, Chemists, South Street, WORTHING, and to Reginald COX, an employee of Taylors Developing & Printing Works, BRIGHTON, being persons not authorized to receive the same under the said act.

in that he

In the Field, on or about 9 November, 1942, communicated photographs of prohibited objects, namely tanks, tank landing craft and other munitions of war, to Walter John SIMMONS, an employee of Messrs. Boots, Chemists, South Street, WORTHING, and to Reginald COX, an employee of Taylors Developing & Printing Works, BRIGHTON, being persons other than persons to whom he was authorized to communicate such photographs.

COMMITTING A CIVIL OFFENCE, THAT IS TO SAY, A BREACH OF DEFENCE (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 1942, PARA 5,

in that he

in the Field, between 7 November 1942 and 9 November 1942, did in a protected place, namely NEW HAVEN, take photographs of prohibited objects, namely tanks, tank landing craft and other munitions of war, contrary to para 5 of Defence (General) Regulations, 1942.
