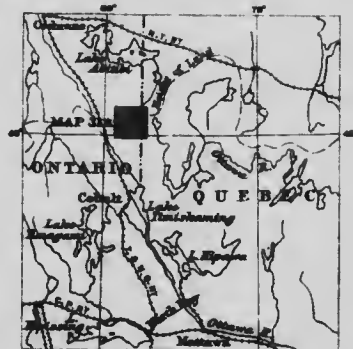
Note. Small areas of sedimentary material not indicated on the map, are known to occur associated with the greenstones and green schists, (Keewatin, 1.)
