

BY-LAWS

(Amended and revised to 28th Oct., 1893.)

ART. I.—NAME.

This society shall be known by the name and title of "The Young Men's Hebrew Benevolent Society of Montreal"

ART. II.—OBJECTS.

The objects of the Society shall be to assist and grant temporary relief to sick and indigent persons of the Hebrew Religion.

ART. III.—MEMBERSHIP.

Any person of the Hebrew Faith and of the age of thirteen years and upwards shall be eligible for membership. The Society shall not be dissolved while ten members remain. Any person may be elected an Associate member of the Society, but such Associate Member shall not be entitled to vote or hold office. Application for membership may be made at any time to the Board of Directors, who shall consider the same as soon as possible, thereupon the Secretary shall notified the applicant of the decision. As a mark of esteem and respect any person may be elected an Honorary Member by a three fourths vote of members present at a general
