have all necessary rights of action and powers for protecting taxes to be the same from spoliation or waste, until the expiration of the thereof, for term during which the land may be redeemed; but he shall certain purnot, knowingly, permit any person to cut timber growing upon ceipt of Treathe land, or otherwise injure the land, nor shall he do so him-surer certifiself, but he may use the land without deteriorating its value; ence Provided that the purchaser shall not be liable for damage done without his knowledge, to the property, during the time the certificate is in force.

144. From the time of a tender to the Treasurer of the full Effect of tender amount of redemption-money required by this Act, the said of arrears, &c. purchaser shall cease to have any further right in or to the land in question.

145. Every Treasurer shall be entitled to two and one-half Treasurer's per cent commission upon the sums collected by him as afore commission.

146. Whenever land is sold by a Treasurer according to Fees, &c., on the provisions of the one hundred and thirty-third and following sales of land: sections of this Act, he may add the commission and costs which he is hereby authorized to charge for the services above mentioned, to the amount of arrears on those lands in respect of which such services have been severally performed, and in every case he shall give a statement in detail with each certificate of sale, of the arrears and costs incurred.

147. The Treasurer shall in all Deeds given for land sold Expenses of at such sale, give a description of the part sold with sufficient search in Recertainty, and if less than a whole lot, then by such a general for description, description as may enable a Surveyor to lay off the piece sold &c on the ground, he may make search, if necessary, in the Registry Office, to ascertain the description and boundaries of the whole parcel, and he may also obtain a Surveyor's description of such lots, to be taken from the Registry Office or the Government maps, where a full description cannot otherwise be obtained, such Surveyor's fee not to exceed one dollar; the charges so incurred shall be included in the account and paid by the purchaser of the land sold.

148. Except as before provided, the Treasurer shall not be Treasurer entitled to any other fees or emoluments whatever for any entitled to no services rendered by him relating to the collection of arrears of other fees. taxes on lands.

149. The owner of any land which may hereafter be sold Owners may, for non-payment of arrears of taxes, for his heirs, executors, within lone administrators or assigns or any other person may at any time estate sold by within one year from the day of calculations of the day of calculations or assigns or any other person may at any time estate sold by within one year from the day of sale, exclusive of that day, paying purchase money redeem the estate sold by paying or tendering to the County and 10 per cent.
