Mr. James Cuthbert moved, feconded by Mr. Mure;

That the confideration of Mr. Mondelet's and Mr. Bedard's propofitions, be deferred until the fifteenth of May; and that in the mean time, communication thereof, with the preceding refolution, be given to Ezekiel Hart, Efquire, by the Clerk of this Houfe; in order that he may thereupon act as he may be advifed.

The Houfe divided on the queftion, and the names being called for, they were taken down as followeth; *Videlicet*:
