

Monies received by him into, and payments by him made from, the Provincial Treasury, commencing the 1st January, and ending the 31st December, 1803.

Ordered, That the said Account do lie on the table, to be perused by the Members of the House.

The Clerk reported that he had, pursuant to order, waited on his Excellency the Lieutenant-Governor, to know when he would be pleased to receive the Address of this House, and that his Excellency had appointed Wednesday next, at one of the Clock, at the Government House.

A Petition of John Lawrence was presented by Mr. Dimock, and read, setting forth, that the Petitioner has sustained an injury by an alteration in the public road leading from Halifax to Windsor, which passes through his Land, and praying a compensation for the same.

Ordered, That the Petition do lie on the table.

A Message from the Council, informing the House, that they had appointed a Committee for examining the Public Accounts, and that the said Committee were ready to meet the Committee of this House, in the Committee Room of the Council, on Monday morning next, at six of the Clock.

Ordered, That the Committee do attend accordingly.

Then the House adjourned until Monday at Twelve of the Clock.

On motion of Mr. M^cMonagle, *resolved*, That a Committee be appointed to examine into, and report to the House, the probable amount of the Ways and Means of the Province for the present year; and also of the sums necessary, in their opinion, to be granted for the several public services during the above period.

Ordered, That Mr. Morris, Mr. M^cCurdy, Mr. Cochran, Mr. Marshall, Mr. Dixon, Mr. M^cMonagle, Mr. Crane, Mr. Moody, Mr. Lovett, Mr. Rutherford, Mr. Dimock, and Mr. Wilkins, be a Committee for the above purpose.

On motion of Mr. Roach, *resolved*, That a Committee be appointed to examine into the Expenditure of all Monies voted for the service of Roads and Bridges, which have not yet been accounted for to the Legislature; and also to consider the amount of the compensation to be allowed to the Commissioners for expending the same, and report thereon to the House.

Ordered, That Mr. M^cMonagle, Mr. Roach, Mr. Pyke, Mr. Lovett, and Mr. Dimock, be a Committee for the above purpose.

On motion, *resolved*, That a Committee be appointed for the purpose of examining into the Expenditure of the sum granted for the New Government House, and reporting thereon to this House.

Ordered, That Mr. Chipman, Mr. Wilkins and Mr. Lyon, be a Committee accordingly.

On motion of Mr. Wilkins, *resolved*, That an account of the receipt and expenditure of the Monies received for the Duty on Licensed Houses, within the district of
