Office, shall be sworn to the faithful Discharge of the Trust reposed in them, and they or the major Part of them shall and may from Time to Time point out to His Excellency such other Places as they may conceive, require Collectors of Impost and Excise, and to inquire into the Conduct of such Collector or Collectors, and report the same to His Excellency, in order that His Excellency may suspend or remove any Collector or Officer of the Provincial Revenue for Neglect or Misbehaviour in Office, and to appoint others in his place, and that it shall and may be Lawful for the said Commissioners to direct and carry on Profecutions against delinquent Officers, Stockholders, or other Provincial Debtors, and also Prosecutions for Seizures and Forfeitures, and any other Breaches of the Laws of Impost and Excise; and also to receive aud examine the quarterly Accounts of the several Collectors, and to arrange and make up the public Accounts, and afcertain the State and Condition of the Provincial Revenue, and to prepare the same for the inspection and Consideration of the General Assembly previous to its being again convened; and that the said Commissioners shall and may appoint a Clerk, to be paid a sum not exceeding Twenty five Pounds per annum by Warrant from the Governor on the Treasury.
