

Shelburne, N. S., Oct .- With all the returns in from the Shelburoe-Queens election Hon. W. S. Field- the night of Oct. 17. The great ing has a majority of 1,181 over hurricane which swept the coast R. C. Weldon, compared with the 385 with which he had in the general election of 1904, when Mr. Fielding's opponent was J.
