Cheering crowds carried Bobby Jones, the new open golf champion, after he defeated Robert Cruickshank in a close match at Inwood.



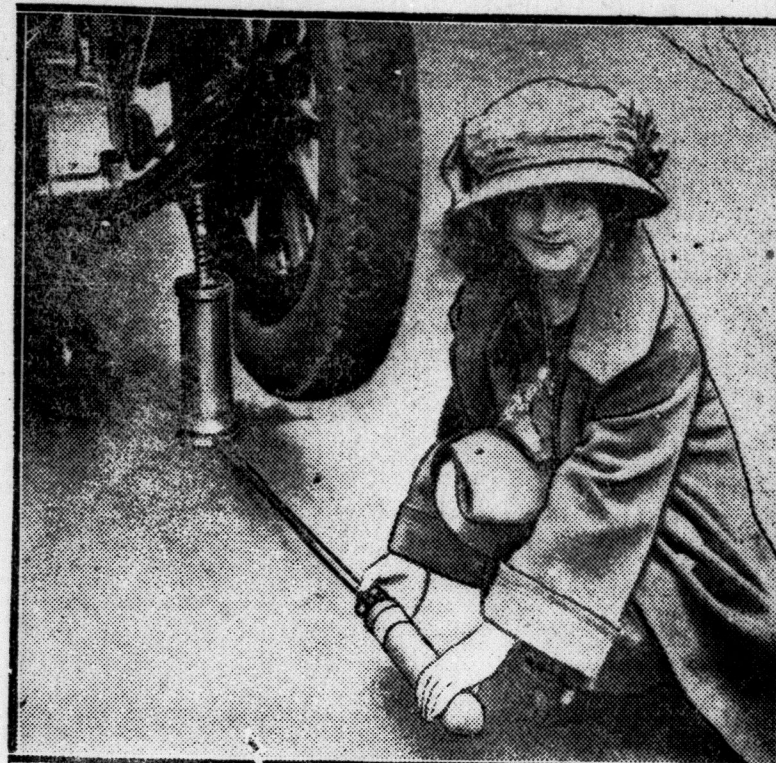
Mike Boyle, famous Labor leader of Chicago, is reported to be sojourning in Canada. Warrants are out for his arrest in connection with bribery charges.



Marie Mindzenty, bride-to-be, is another fair lady who claims the distinction of being the most beautiful woman on the continent.



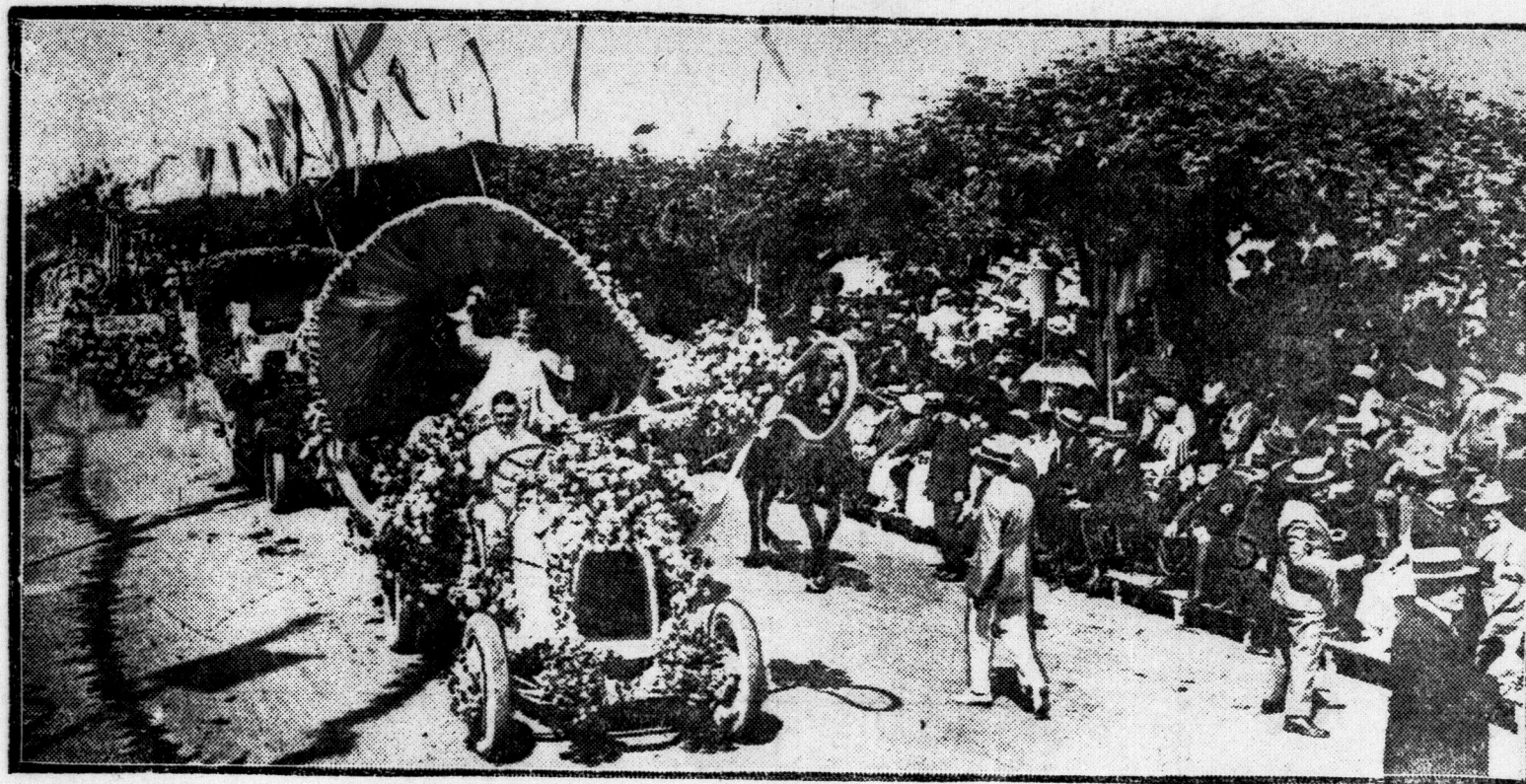

Millions of flowers are used to decorate the floats and streets for the great flower festival, which is held yearly at Geneva, Switzerland.



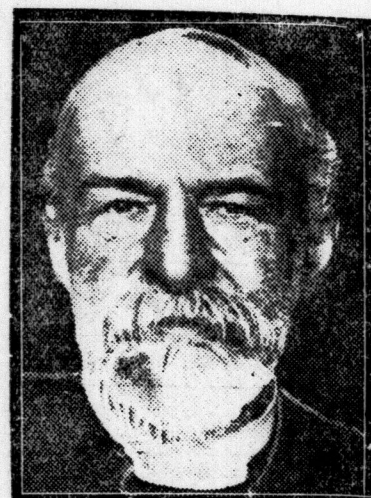

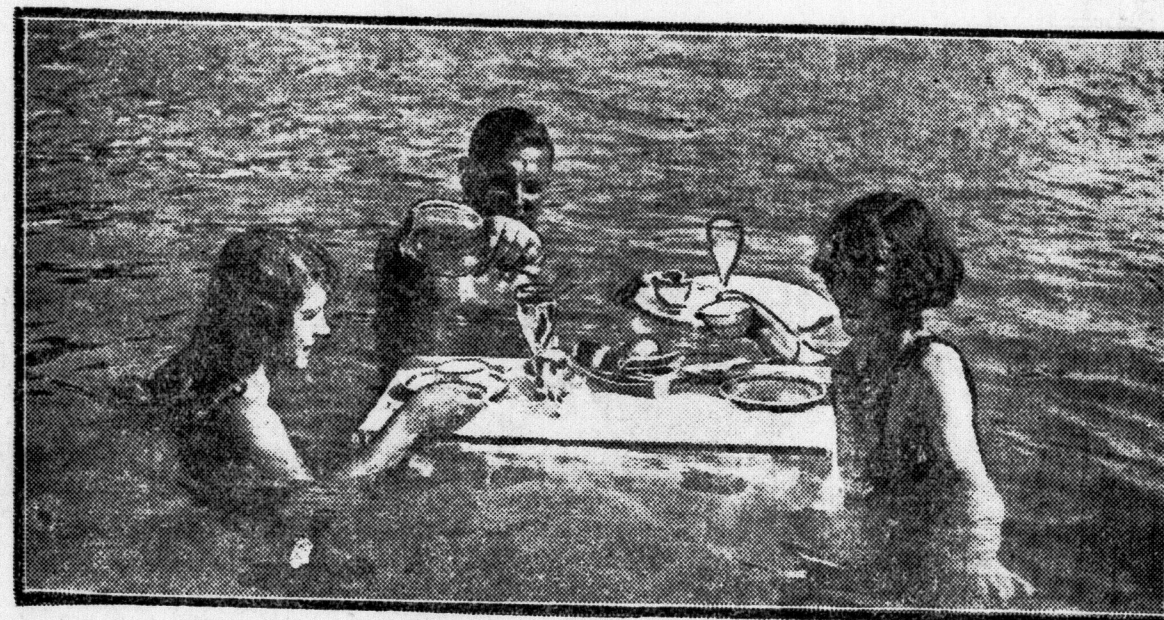
Not a quartet of jailbirds, but merely a scene on the beach at Ostend, the popular Belgium summer resort. Striped beach costumes are all the rage here.
