Cayley played well for his 20, Macdonell made 25 (not out) without a chance, and Logan quickly put together 27, the innings closing for 96. The Past sent in Saunders (Guelph) and Bletcher (Port Hope) to face the bowling of Macdonell and Allan. Bletcher quickly gave place to Hall (Guelph), and I e and Saunders gave a splendid exhibition of good batting. Hall unfortunately hit his wicket after having made 13. Howard (Toronto) made no stand, and Merritt, 12, was the only other outside of Saunders who made double figures. The latter's batting was perfect. His 84 (not out) was made without a chance, and he was loudly cheered at the close of the innings.

The Present then went in for their second innings, Macdonell again getting double figures, 17, and Ince and Lauder making 13 and 14 respectively, the whole innings closing for 79. The Past, with 33 to win, then began to play, and succeeded in getting the required number of runs for the loss of four wickets, Ross (not out) 17, and Martin, sub. for Bletcher, 11.
