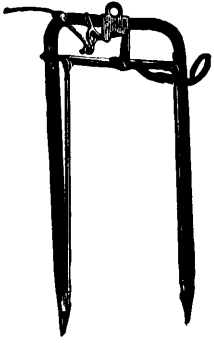


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**FIRST PASSENGER:** "Would you be good enough to lend me your spectacles a moment?"
