EXCELLENCY,

In your note of today's date, Your Excellency has communicated the following to me:

"I have the honour to refer to the agreement between the Government of Canada and the Swiss Federal Council concerning air services, signed today at Berne, and to propose that, pending ratification by our respective Governments, the provisions of the agreement be brought into force temporarily.

I should be grateful to learn whether the Swiss Federal Council approves this proposal. If such be the case, I suggest that this letter and your reply thereto constitute an arrangement to that effect between our two Governments, which will come into force immediately."

I have the honour to confirm that the Federal Council is agreeable to the foregoing.
