At Headquarters and at Regional Passport Offices in Montreal, Fredericton and Ottawa

Supervision will be provided according to the language requirements of the subordinate position. For example:

- incumbents of unilingual positions will be supervised in the language of that position;
- incumbents of either/or positions will be supervised in the official language of choice of the incumbent;
- incumbents of bilingual positions will be supervised in their official language of choice.

At all other Regional Passport Offices

You will be supervised in the language of the majority population of the province in which the office is located.

6. Communications Between Offices

As both English and French are the languages of work at headquarters, Regional Passport Offices in Montreal, Fredericton and Ottawa, and missions, communications between these offices may be in either official language. The responsibility for understanding the communication will rest with the receiving office.

If you request "personal" or "central" services from headquarters, they are to be provided in your official language of choice.

Telegrams, directives, notices, circulars, instructions or other documents of a general or administrative nature having a wide distribution are to be transmitted simultaneously in both official languages.

Communications to offices of the Department or to those of other departments located in Quebec must be in the language or
