

GUIDE TO THE USERS

The index is subject-based and cross-referenced. A 90 in volume 11 indicates the committee with the current working name and subject the following "Index and Tables" on the following page. Table numbers are indicated by "tbl" after the subject.

The index provides general subject matter as well as cross-referencing to the subject matter. The names of individual members of Parliament. All subject matter in the index are arranged alphabetically.

The index is cross-referenced. Cross-references to a sub-heading are indicated by a long dash "—" for example:

Organizations appearing above all agencies of organizations under the Committee, the Index of Members and Committee members and subjects for the index are listed by the Committee, the Index of Members and Committee members under the name of a procedural matter including those listed in the Minutes.

The most common abbreviations found in the index are as follows:

- M - Member
- ND - Non-Declaratory Bill
- PO - Private Member's Question
- PP - Private Member's Question
- Q - Question
- R - Report
- SC - Standing Order
