Right Hon. Mr. MACKENZIE KING:

1. The government is aware that Mr. T. G. Mackenzie has been taken prisoner by bandits in Mexico (Villistas) and held for ransom.

2. The government has caused the attention of H. M. Ambassador at Washington to be called to this matter, and His Majesty's Chargé d'Affaires at Mexico was asked to take steps for Mr. Mackenzie's immediate release and protection. The Chargé d'Affaires took the matter up with the government of Mexico and was assured that "no effort will be spared to recover Mr. Mackenzie". Reports have been received from time to time from the Chargé d'Affaires at Mexico, but Mr. Mackenzie has not as yet been released, although he is said to be well and making himself popular with his captors.

3. His Majesty's government has been informed of the capture of Mr. Mackenzie through His Majesty's Ambassador at Wash-

1. Up to February 29 last, the cost of the installation of the new electric generating plant at Banff was \$184,619.01.
