My dear General,

Your letter has furnished me with above address, where I am visiting cases in the extreme north east of Scotland. I go from here to Orkney Islands and onto the Shetland Group.

Of course I am delighted to undertake your mission and as many more such as you care to ask me to do, and will do my best to find out all I can about MacNeil.

It will be $3\frac{1}{2}$ weeks before I am back in Edinburgh, until then I can do nothing. If I were to write about it, everyone would at once commence sniffing the wind.

Now from General what I would suggest is this. I am, as you know it, more of "trans" "re" Edinburgh. I am really out of it about 8 months in the year, and although I know a good deal of the comparative values of the men it will be much more difficult for me to make inquiries than one who is right in the midst of things. How my inquiries would have to be extremely tactful. All the docs in Edinburgh know about any Canadian feelings and sympathies, they also know that MacNeil
