exploded, and have proved a fource of misfortune to this country, yet it is neither wife nor neceffary that fhe fhould abandon her remaining colonies on the continent, except it fhould alfo appear to be for her intereft to give up the fifheries, the Weft India iflands, her Eaft India poffeffions, and, eventually, her formidable navy. But, when other maritime nations have put in practice fuch leffons, it will then be time enough for Britain to learn them.

In the prefent fituation of things, her unfortunate faithful fubjects in America call aloud on her humanity, and claim that grateful attention, which is equally due to their attachment and their fufferings. While this is beftowed, there are objects at home which cannot be neglected, without diminishing the national grandeur, and ultimately affecting the happines of individuals. It is the interest of our country to attend to the following things.
