CHAPTER 103

AN ACT RESPECTING THE MERCHANTS BANK OF HALIFAX, AND TO CHANGE ITS NAME TO "THE ROYAL BANK OF CANADA"

[Assented to 14th June, 1900]

THEREAS the Merchants Bank of Halifax has, by its petition, Preamble prayed that it be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. The name of the Merchants Bank of Halifax is changed Name to "The Royal Bank of Canada," but such change in name shall changed not in any way impair, alter or affect the rights or liabilities of Existing the said Bank, nor in anywise affect any suit or proceeding now rights pending, or judgment existing either by or in favour of or against the said Bank, which, notwithstanding such change in name, may be prosecuted, continued, completed and enforced as if this Act had not been passed.

2. Before this Act shall take effect, a general meeting of the When Act shareholders of the said Bank shall be called for the purpose of to come considering it, and a resolution accepting and approving thereof shall be passed by the shareholders present or represented by proxy at such meeting, and a certified copy of such resolution shall, within fifteen days after the passing thereof, be published in The Canada Gazette, and this Act shall take effect from the date of such publication.
