

## STILL TOO MANY CATTLE ON SALE

Not So Many Fresh Arrivals, But Number of Left-Overs.

### DECLINED IN PRICE

Stockers and Feeders Were Slow Sale on Yesterday's Market.

Receipts of live stock at the Union Stock Yards on Thursday were 49 cars, comprising 171 cattle, 210 hogs, 132 sheep and lambs and 77 calves. Business at the live stock yards on Thursday was as nearly as could be a repetition of Wednesday's market. In nearly every case, there were still too many cattle on sale, although only 171 were fresh arrivals, but there were five or six hundred left over, many of which were in poor condition. The top value for choice stock of cattle was \$2.25.

Stockers and feeders were slow sale at a decline of about 25c per cwt., but still too high.

The demand for milkers and springers of choice quality was again strong, many orders having gone unfilled, but prices were no higher.

Calves, sheep and lambs ruled steady at unchanged quotations. Hogs were a little easier in values.

The sole head of a family, or any male over eighteen years old, may homestead a quarter-section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. Application must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Proxy Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Dominion Lands Agency (but not Sub-Agency) on certain conditions.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within the limits of his homesteaded land for at least eighty acres, on certain conditions. A homesteaded house is required, except where residence is performed in the vicinity.

In certain districts a homesteader in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alongside his hom
