hands of the French till the year 1710, in the reign of Queen Anne, when it was reduced to the English by an army from New England under the command of General Nicolson.

Upon the capitulation of the garrison of Port Royal, since call'd Annapolis Royal, in honour to Queen Anne, the inhabitants obtained leave to continue in the possession of their estates, and enjoyment of their religion, (which is that of the Roman catholick) only upon taking an oath of sidelity to the Queen, and paying a small quit-rent, as an acknowledgement to the crown; to be also
